

Haiti Disaster Relief Effort

On January 12, 2010 a 7.0-earthquake devastated the nation of Haiti. Currently, 200,000 are presumed dead in Port-au-Prince alone. Many of the survivors are now fighting for their lives from disease and infections.

Giving Children Hope responded quickly to send aid. We have:

- Sent four teams to Haiti were equipped with supplies which included over \$100,000 of medical supplies and pharmaceuticals. All supplies were hand-carried into Haiti.
- Sent \$4.7 million worth of pharmaceuticals have been sent to Haiti to help stop disease and treat infections.
- Shipped 57,000 pounds of medical supplies and humanitarian aid worth over \$500,000 have been air-freight into Haiti.
- We have shipped 40,000 lbs of beans and 40,000 lbs of rice and corn
- Another two truckloads of relief are leaving for Haiti this week and next week. The shipments will include medical supplies, food, clothing and personal hygiene worth \$500,000.
- Additionally, with our partner, we will be sending \$400,000 worth of medical supplies, food, blankets, hygiene kits and pharmaceuticals.



Giving Children Hope has sent two teams into Haiti to administer aid and further assess the needs on the ground. We also have a 200,000 sq. ft secure facility in Haiti that will serve as our disaster relief distribution center to the people of Haiti.

The team has:

- Brought medical supplies and food to a refugee camp housing 17,000 people.
- Opened more channels of distribution to get aid into the country quicker.
- Helped administer aid to the sick and injured.
