**Position Objective:**

To begin the process of more fully learning of Korean-American (K-A) mission needs for “in-kind” (material) products by collecting an expanded contact file, advertising Giving Children Hope (GCHope) product, and designing a strategy to connect K-A entities with GCHope to help special mission projects around the world.

**Phase I – Research a Contact File (May – July)**

Create a contact file of names and data on K-A churches, missionaries, medical relief organizations, K-A businesses, and wealthy celebrities. Special emphasis on email addresses of key individuals.

Giving Children Hope is a faith-based humanitarian aid organization which focuses on health care issues, relief, refugee assistance and projects serving needy children and the poor. A Public Benefit, non-profit corporation, registered Private Volunteer Organization (PVO) with USAID, Tax exempt under IRC 501 c (3).



## **Phase II – Advertise Medical Product (Aug-Oct)**

Create letters, flyers, brochure advertising GCHope product to K-A entities. Emphasis on pharmaceuticals, medical supplies and equipment, and relief goods available. Mail and email offers to the contact list. Select special churches, organizations, businesses, wealthy persons to visit.

Recruit high school and college students to raise funds for special shipments, medical mission trips, and relief endeavors.

## **Phase III – Design Strategies for Persecuted Church (Nov – Jan)**

Design strategies to further appeal to K-A organizations and individuals regarding relief for North Korea and the persecuted church. Plan for a conference at GCHope by inviting various organizations like Open Doors, Voice of the Martyrs, ASSIST News Services, and Mission Network News.
