



Overview:

Giving Children Hope (GCHope) conducts medical surplus recovery. On average we receive 40 pallets of medical surplus per week valued at \$300,000 wholesale much of which would end up in our limited landfill space. We sort, inspect, refurbish, package and distribute locally, nationally, and around the world.

Programs:

Giving Children Hope distributes in the following ways:

- The **We've Got Your Back** program is our local direct service program that serves homeless elementary children in Orange County. GCHope works through the schools and the Orange County Department of Education to supply 700 of the over 22,000 **homeless children** in Orange County with nutrition education and food weekly.
- Our **Mobile Medical Clinic** currently operates one day per week in Orange County treating the homeless. Long-term goals include refurbishing it with dental chairs to allow for it those in need of general care or dental care. Currently the targeted population the clinic serves is using the ER as their primary care facility where the costs are much greater.
- Our **Pharmaceutical Program** distributes pharmaceutical packages that serve 25,000 individuals to small clinics in developing countries. The pharmaceutical package includes life-saving medicines such as anti-worming and anti-malaria medicines.
- Our **Clinic Development Program** serves small in-country clinics with all of the supplies, equipment and pharmaceuticals needed to open or refurbish a clinic in areas that have no access to healthcare. We have an on-site biotech department that re-furbishes equipment for use in a developing country.
- Our **Disaster Relief Program** quickly and efficiently gets supplies to emergency disaster situations. GCHope was a first responder in Haiti after it was hit by a 7.0 earthquake in 2010. GCHope distributed over **\$5 million** worth of life-saving supplies and medicines to Haitians in need.
- The **Giving for Living** program serves over 130 nonprofit organizations in Southern California on a weekly basis with the supplies they need to run their organizations – from pregnancy centers to homeless shelters to drug rehab programs – GCHope helps local nonprofits fulfill their unique mission.
- Our **Mission Store** is open from Monday through Friday and has on average 65 visitors per week. Visitors are local nonprofit organizations, churches, or missionaries from around the world who come for over-the-counter medicines, hygiene, and beauty supplies.

High Impact: Giving Children Hope is a high-impact organization. For every \$1 donated Giving Children Hope is able to distribute \$37 in needed product locally, nationally and around the world – over **99% of all donations** go towards program services.
